All this information is relevant for your safety on site. But the biggest contributing factor to workplace injuries and incidents is that workers become complacent in their tasks and the environment around them. Have you:

- Cut through the warehouse rather than follow the designated foot path?
- Not followed the traffic management plan by either travelling too fast within an area on any piece of equipment or vehicle or traveled in the wrong direction?
- Knowingly overloaded a forklift or EPJ?
- Not followed a policy / process / safe work method exactly as trained / inducted?
- Operated a piece of equipment without either reading the safe work methods or safe working limits of the equipment?
- Knowingly completed a task in an unsafe manner?
- Or have just fallen into a bad habits?

Situational awareness is about knowing what is going on around you and knowing what others close by are doing. Taking the time to work in a safe manner and thinking about what you are about to do can help keep you and your colleagues safe.

Please, do not become complacent.
